CNA & PCT & Dialysis Technician & Pre-LPN

Overview:

This program prepares a graduate to work as an entry-level Nurse, Nurse Aide, Patient Care Technician, Dialysis Technician in a clinic, hospital, nursing home or long-term care facility. Graduates will be able to check vital signs, assist in medical examinations, perform electrocardiograms (EKGs), basic laboratory procedures, phlebotomy and operate a dialysis machine CPR and First Aid. This program is taught with a combination of lecture, practical exercises in the medical laboratory and **with real-world experience during the externship portion of training conducted off-campus at medical facilities.**

In addition, this course will prepare a graduate for an LPN Entrance (Pre-LPN) exams (Basic Math & Science, Basic English Reading & Writing). You will also be eligible to take exams to become a Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA)

Graduates are prepared for the following certifications by the National Healthcare Association (NHA)

- Certified Patient Care Technician (CPCT)
- Certified EKG Technician (CET) & Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT)

The course curriculum is approved by the New York State Education Department, by Accrediting Council for Continuing Education and Training (ACCET) and by National Health Career Association (NHA).

This course is recommended for anyone considering a nursing career, and it is designed for those (men and women) looking for employment as a nurse aide / assistant, and patient care technician and **specially for students who are planning to continue a nursing career in LPN or RN programs.**
